## **Travel costs**

Travel to provide personal care and community access - Your NDIS plan will be charged for the time it takes for a support worker to travel to your house to complete support. This can be up to a maximum of 30 minutes.

Accompanying participants for community access - When a worker is supporting you from your home to engage in your community during support that requires transport then travel costs will be charged at 0.90 cents per kilometre. Participants will also be invoiced for any parking costs or use of public transport whilst with a participant.

## **Other Costs**

The NDIS will not pay for entry into social/recreational venues when workers are supporting participants in the community (unless social and community costs are specifically stated in the plan). We will always strive to find free alternatives, however if the participant agrees this cost can be billed to them to allow their attendance.

It is recommended that participants who require the assistance of a worker in the community apply for a companion card to cover the cost of this.

## **Non-Face-to-Face Fees**

To enable PTR to provide a quality service to all participants, there are administration tasks (non-face-to-face supports) that we will need to add to your service booking. This includes time for writing care plans; reports and ISP's. This will be detailed in your Service Agreement and charged at the standard hourly rate for Core Support.

## **Shadow Shifts**

If it is deemed necessary by the participant/family to introduce new workers through the provision of a 'shadow shift' due to complex circumstances, then 6 hours of Core Support (weekday rate) will be charged against the plan per year.
