Core Supports

Assistance with self-care activities:

Establishment Fee

An Establishment Fee is charged against an NDIS Plan where we have been chosen to deliver more than 20 hours personal care/community access support each month. This assists in the development of the first Care Plan, which is additional to in-person support provided.

Travel costs

The cost of travel will only be applied to your support in the following circumstances:

- Travel to provide personal care and community access - If a support worker needs to travel more than 15 minutes to your home to complete core supports then any time over the first 15 minutes will be counted as time in the first hour of support (up to a total of 20 minutes). The first 15 minutes of travel is free and not charged to a participant.
- Travel to provide Therapeutic Supports (including Behavioural Support) – If a specialist employee (including Social Workers) travels more than 15km to provide support to a participant then the travel will be charged to a participant's plan at the following rate:
 - Claimable travel time (in minutes) = (total km travelled – 15/60)
- Accompanying participants for community access - When a worker is supporting you from your home to engage in your community during support that requires travel of more than 5km then travel costs will be charged at 0.78 cents per kilometre to cover the worker's petrol costs.

We do not charge the cost of travel between appointments (except in the above circumstances only).

Other Costs

PTR will provide all workers with Metrocards where public transport can be used. This will not be charged to the participant.

The NDIS has indicated that they will not pay for entry into social/recreational venues when workers are supporting participants in the community (unless social and community costs are specifically stated in the plan). We will always strive to find free alternatives, however if the participant agrees this cost can be billed to them to allow their attendance.

It is recommended that participant's who require the assistance of a worker in the community apply for a companion card to cover the cost of this.

Shadow Shifts

If it is deemed necessary by the participant/family to introduce new workers through the provision of a 'shadow shift' due to complex circumstances, then 6 hours of Core Support (weekday rate) will be charged against the plan per year.
